## Six Figure Settlement Imminent in Orr Case

Sources present at Superior Court in Plymouth told Fixcarver that a settlement payment agreement in the range of \$100,000 has been reached in the Ray Orr demotion case.

The case has been winding its way through the legal system for more than ten years and through the tenure of 4 chiefs of police. Current Police Chief Michael Miksch and Senior Sergeant Ray Orr were seen in the Plymouth Superior Court building Wednesday afternoon June 13, 2012 after apparently completing work on the agreement. Miksch, who inherited this nightmare, is not in the crosshairs of Fixcarver but it is clear that other town officials continued the case long after any reasonable hope for winning it vanished. Orr was reinstated to the position of Senior Sergeant by a Civil Service Judge in late 2009 without loss of compensation. The judgment has been accumulating interest since then. Frank Casey please tell us again who is batting a thousand. According to our sources Ray Orr is batting a hundred thousand. We think the taxpayers have been punished enough. It's time for someone to be held accountable for this fiasco. Carver desperately needs clear thinking and good legal advice.
