Zoning Board of Appeals Violated Open Meeting Law

In a letter dated March 6, 2011 Attorney General's Martha Coakley's Office found the Zoning Board of Appeals in violation of the Open Meeting Law. The AG cited the ZBA for failing to respond within 10 days of a December 28, 2010 open meeting request by Bob Belbin. The Board finally responded to the request on May 31, 2011 a full 144 days late! The Attorney General stated "***It does appear that Mr. Belbin made repeated attempts between December 28, 2010 and May 10, 2011 to obtain copies of these meetings.***"

According to Assistant Attorney General Jonathan Sclarsic "There is some question as to when the Board actually received the letter, as it was filed with the Town administrative offices and may not have reached the Board".

The Attorney General's Office ordered immediate and future compliance with the law. Martha Coakley's Office is fully aware of the concerns of Dr. Hewins and the other law breakers in Carver. Apparently this is their response to her concerns.
